



Case Study : Stewart Milne VC Rollout

To provide comprehensive and cost effective video conferencing solution to link key offices around the UK as well as specified presentation technologies.



Background:

Stewart Milne is an Aberdeen-based Construction Group founded in 1975 as a housebuilding contractor. Its chairman & Chief Exec earned the 2005 Scottish Entrepreneur of the Year award and the company is reportedly worth in excess of £400million

Project:

Scotia UK was asked to provide Video Conferencing Suites for 9 meeting rooms from Aberdeen to Oxford. There was also a requirement for presentation technology as the staff members and guests would bring Laptops to show content.

The Solution:

Depending on the size of the meeting room, we used single and dual screen set ups and also put together a portable VC solution for the training room. The Polycom Group 500 has the ability to switch between sources so we could use this to run the HDMI and VGA connectivity for presentations as well as a Video Conferencing solution. All of the rooms required additional speakers which could also be controlled by the single VC control.

There was a requirement for supplementary ceiling microphones in some rooms although the standard Microphone was often sufficient due to the 360 degree omnidirectional pick-up.

The Outcome:

The overall project including hardware, installation, configuration and multiple training sessions around the UK was delivered on time, on budget and in a positive and controlled manner.
